This past Friday Ambassadors hosted a tour of State St. and staffed an info table at the resource fair for the first Your UW Days event of 2015. This event is for prospective students who have been accepted, but not yet admitted into the University, as well as their families. During the event Ambassadors made contact with 171 prospective students and family members, while distributing hundreds of Downtown Maps and other Downtown related brochures.
