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Shake the Lake, Sat. June 27
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[Live on King Street Summer Concert Series starts June 26](#)

Majestic Madison's free summer concerts series in the 100 block of King Street. Future dates are Fridays July 17 and 31, Aug. 7 and 21, and Sep. 18. On concert days, the 100 block of King St will be closed down starting at 8am to vehicular traffic, and the stage will be built in its normal location at the bottom of the block. The street and sidewalk will be clean and back open to traffic by 1am. Gates open at 6pm and amplified music ends by 11pm. Access to all businesses will be maintained throughout the event via a fenced path along the north side of the street starting at the Topsy Cow corner and ending at Opus. This path will be set in place after the patios are broken down by 7pm, and event security will staff the path to maintain access to all businesses.

Fireworks on Lake Monona. Programs start at 5pm, fireworks at 10pm. John Nolen Drive will be closed between Blair St. and Broom St. from 6am on 6/27 until 6am on 6/28. Broom Street will remain open to and from John Nolen Drive. Wilson Street and Williamson Street will also remain open. [GSSBA Membership and Maxwell Street Days Vendor Application \(deadline July 10\)](#)

The Maxwell Street Days Summer Sidewalk Sale is July 17-19. This annual State Street event attracts 30,000 people downtown for shopping and dining. The Greater State Street Business Association (GSSBA) presents on Maxwell Street Days with support from BID.

GSSBA gets a daytime "exclusive use permit" for State Street for Maxwell Street Days. Only those with Maxwell vending permits can vend outside or have an outdoor cafe on State Street July 17-19 during Maxwell Street Days hours (Friday-Saturday 8am to 6pm, and Sunday 10am to 5pm). "Exclusive use" supersedes other permits (outdoor cafes, sidewalk vending). Only GSSBA members can apply for Maxwell Street Days vending permits. GSSBA membership is open to all businesses and property owners located on State Street, Capitol Square and one block off in either of these two areas. Even if you are

not going to vend outside during Maxwell Street Days, you are encouraged to join GSSBA if the event benefits your business. Your membership helps fund the marketing and promotion that brings people downtown and to your business during the event.

Mall Maintenance Sidewalk Washing Program update

The City [Mall Maintenance](#) intensive sidewalk washing program runs through early Oct., weather permitting. The program includes general pavement cleaning, detailed cleaning around benches & trash cans, and some gum removal. They will clean a specific area 2-3 days, from 6:30am to no later than 11:30am. If you have a sidewalk café, when they are cleaning in front of your business you will not be able to set up until after they are done (no later than 11:30 am). This project wouldn't close sidewalks completely, so access will be maintained to all businesses, but there will be some impacts to sidewalk cafes, etc., when they are working in front of your business.
