Kids' Day at Top of State

Outdoor games, play and fun with the Wisconsin Historical Museum, MSCR FIT2GO Van, Madison Central Library, and Madison Children's Museum. (Children must be accompanied by adult; no drop offs.)

The programming is designed to activate Top of State public spaces (Philosophers' Grove, 30 on the Square), increase positive uses of these area, and enhance them for the community and business/cultural district. The mix of programs will range from markets to music, arts and crafts, children's activities, resource fairs and learning opportunities, and pop-up or drop-in events. Introductory events will be in June, with events added throughout the summer and continuing through September (but not conflicting with already-scheduled events such as Art Fair on the Square, Maxwell Street Days or Jazz at Five.) Upcoming events will include Ian's Pizza Outdoor Open Mic, children's activities provided by Wisconsin Historical Museum, Madison Central Library, Madison Children's Museum, and events with other partners. The programming is supported with funding from the City of Madison and private sector donors via the Madison Parks Foundation, and with the media partnership of Isthmus. GSSBA Membership and Maxwell Street Days Vendor Application – discounted sign up before June 17

The Maxwell Street Days Summer Sidewalk Sale is July 17-19. This annual State Street event attracts 30,000 people downtown for shopping and dining. The Greater State Street Business Association (GSSBA) presents on Maxwell Street Days with support from BID.

GSSBA gets a daytime "exclusive use permit" for State Street for Maxwell Street Days. Only those with Maxwell vending permits can vend outside or have an outdoor cafe on State Street July 17-19 during Maxwell Street Days hours (Friday-Saturday 8am to 6pm, and Sunday 10am to 5pm). "Exclusive use" supersedes other permits (outdoor cafes, sidewalk vending). Only GSSBA members can apply for Maxwell Street Days vending permits. GSSBA membership is open to all businesses and property owners located on State Street, Capitol Square and one block off in either of these two areas. Even if you are not going to vend outside during Maxwell Street Days, you are encouraged to join GSSBA if the event benefits your business. Your membership helps fund the marketing and promotion that brings people downtown and to your business during the event.

Mall Maintenance Sidewalk Washing Program update

The City [Mall Maintenance](#) intensive sidewalk washing program runs through early Oct., weather permitting. The program includes general pavement cleaning, detailed cleaning around benches & trash cans, and some gum removal. They will clean a specific area 2-3 days, from 6:30am to no later than 11:30am. If you have a sidewalk café, when they are cleaning in front of your business you will not be able to set up until after they are done (no later than 11:30 am). Construction Updates

City Sidewalk Repairs on State St.

The city will do sidewalk joint repairs on State St. (100-600 blocks) along with some spot sidewalk repairs, July 20 - August 13. They would work in any one spot 4-5 days. This project wouldn't close sidewalks completely, so access will be maintained to all businesses, but there will be some impacts to sidewalk cafes, etc., when they are working in front of your business. Tree Replacement

The city will be removing/replanting a number of dead street trees in the State St./Capitol Square area April-June. They will try to schedule work first thing in the morning to avoid sidewalk cafes, pedestrians, and road traffic. There may be some short term sidewalk closure when the contractors or city staff are digging at a site.
