Vehicles on State Street

In order to maximize safety and convenience for foot traffic to local businesses, State Street should be utilized as a pedestrian mall. As a result, this reminder is going out to educate and ensure compliance by all businesses which operate on State St.

Private Vehicles are allowed on State Street in very limited circumstances, with a 30 minute maximum time limit, and **ONLY** when a valid State Street Auto Permit is displayed:

- Maintenance being performed at a State St. business
- **ACTIVELY** loading/unloading at a State St. business, when items would be a **significant encumbrance** to carry to or from legal parking
- Dropping off or picking up persons with a disability that would limit that individual's ability to walk to a location on State St.

Entrance to/exit from State St. should be made at the nearest intersection. Vehicles should not be traveling multiple blocks along State St. when coming and going. Permit should be retrieved from State St. business immediately upon arrival at business and displayed in front windshield. If more than 30 minutes is required, loading/unloading should be done on State St., and legal parking, off of State St., should be utilized in the meantime. Permits are **NOT** to be used to operate a delivery business/service from businesses on State St.

Any parking on State St. should be done in a manner that allows for buses and emergency vehicles to travel freely upon the roadway.

*Reminder – No (Semi/Delivery) Truck Stopping, Standing or Parking on State Street from 11:30am to 1:30pm. Deliveries to businesses should be scheduled outside of these hours.

- ❖ Vehicles and their operators in violation of State St. parking or traveling rules may be subject to Parking Citation or Traffic Citation, as all intersections are marked that only authorized vehicles are allowed turns onto State St.
